Four Transfers are scheduled for consideration on May 23, 2023. The orders under consideration are attached and referenced by order number for your convenience.

Budget Order 2023-131 Community Benefit Plan

The <u>Local Improvement Distribution Program</u> requires an Appropriations Transfer to appropriate funding not known at the adoption of the budget. This requires an increase in Transfers Out of \$200,000, and a decrease in Contingency of \$200,000.

Budget Order 2023-132 Capital Purchases Management

The <u>Capital Purchases Management Program</u> requires an Appropriations Transfer to appropriate funding not known at the adoption of the budget. This requires an increase in Materials & Services of \$20,000, and a decrease in Contingency of \$20,000.

Budget Order 2023-133 Victim Witness Assessment
