

Request for Proposal
12" Well Casing Piles for Bridge Foundation Repair

Umatilla County Public Works is requesting proposals for the placement of 10-12" drilled well casings for the purpose of foundation repair of a county bridge on Blue Mountain Station Road.

The drilled casings need to be placed a minimum of 8 feet into bed rock. Bedrock on the East side of the bridge is estimated to be at 20 feet and bedrock on the West side varies from 5 feet to 18 feet in depth. We are requesting drilling and placement of the casing to be completed no later than March 31, 2026

General plans for this work are available at the Umatilla County Public Works office at 3920 Westgate, Pendleton, Oregon between the hours of 6:30 am to 5:00 pm Monday through Thursday. A copy of the foundation plan is attached.

Proposals shall be made on a unit price basis per foot of installed well casing measured from the tip to the cutoff. The unit price will include mobilization, demobilization, supplying the specified casing, drilling, and installation of the casing to the depth specified. Estimated total casing required is approximately 200 feet but may vary depending on actual depth to bedrock. No adjustments to the unit price will be made for quantities differing from the estimated quantity.

Proposals need to be delivered to the Umatilla County Public Works Directors office at 3920 Westgate, Pendleton, Oregon, 97801 no later than 4 PM on February 17, 2026 and should be clearly marked as Blue Mountain Station Road foundation proposal.
