WHEREAS the Board of Commissioners has adopted a Comprehensive Plan for Umatilla County;

WHEREAS pursuant to ORS 195.036 the Board of Commissioners is to establish and maintain a population forecast for the entire area its boundary for use in maintaining and updating comprehensive plans, and shall coordinate the forecast with the local governments within its boundary;

WHEREAS the Department of Administrative Service's Office of Economic Analysis (OEA) prepared a population forecast for Umatilla County;

WHEREAS in 1999, after input from the cities, the approved OEA forecasted population was disaggregated among the rural area and the 12 cities within Umatilla County;

WHEREAS on November 3, 1999, the Board of Commissioners officially recognized the disaggregated population figures pursuant to ORS 195.036 and communicated this recognition to the Office of Economic Analysis;

WHEREAS the Comprehensive Plan is to be amended to update the recognized population figures for the communities and rural area of Umatilla County based on the recognized disaggregated population;

WHEREAS the Umatilla County Planning Commission held a public hearing on May 27, 2004 to review the proposed amendment to the plan and recommended that the Board of Commissioners adopt the amendment, to add the updated population figures based on the OEA population disaggregation.

WHEREAS the Board of Commissions held a public hearing on June 30, 2004, to consider the proposed amendment, and voted for the approval of the amendment.

NOW, THEREFORE the Board of Commissioners of Umatilla County ordains that the Umatilla County Comprehensive Plan, adopted May 9, 1983, be amended to update the population amounts of Umatilla County and its 12 cities, set out in Chapter II, General Description of Umatilla County, page I-9, to reflect the population as provided in the attached table, incorporated by this reference. The amounts are updated to indicate the population as of 1998, with the forecasted population for years 2000 and beyond.
