**DEDICATION:** KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That I, we, the undersigned of Pendleton, Umatilla County, Oregon; Owners and claimants in the herein described tract do hereby declare and acknowledge the accompanying to be the authorized plat of Mission Tracts at Mission Indian Agency East of Pendleton, Umatilla County, Oregon; and we do give, grant and dedicate to the use of the public as streets and alleys and public highways, all streets and alleys shown on said plat and owned by the undersigned, including that portion described as follows: From the point of beginning of this described tract, thence N. 0° 12' 30" W., 774.25 Ft. to a point 30.2 Ft. east of the west line of said tract, thence S. 0° 31' W., 774.25 Ft., thence east and parallel with the east-west center line of said section 10, 105.25 Ft. to the point of beginning, which is not apparently used as a portion of County Road No. 805.

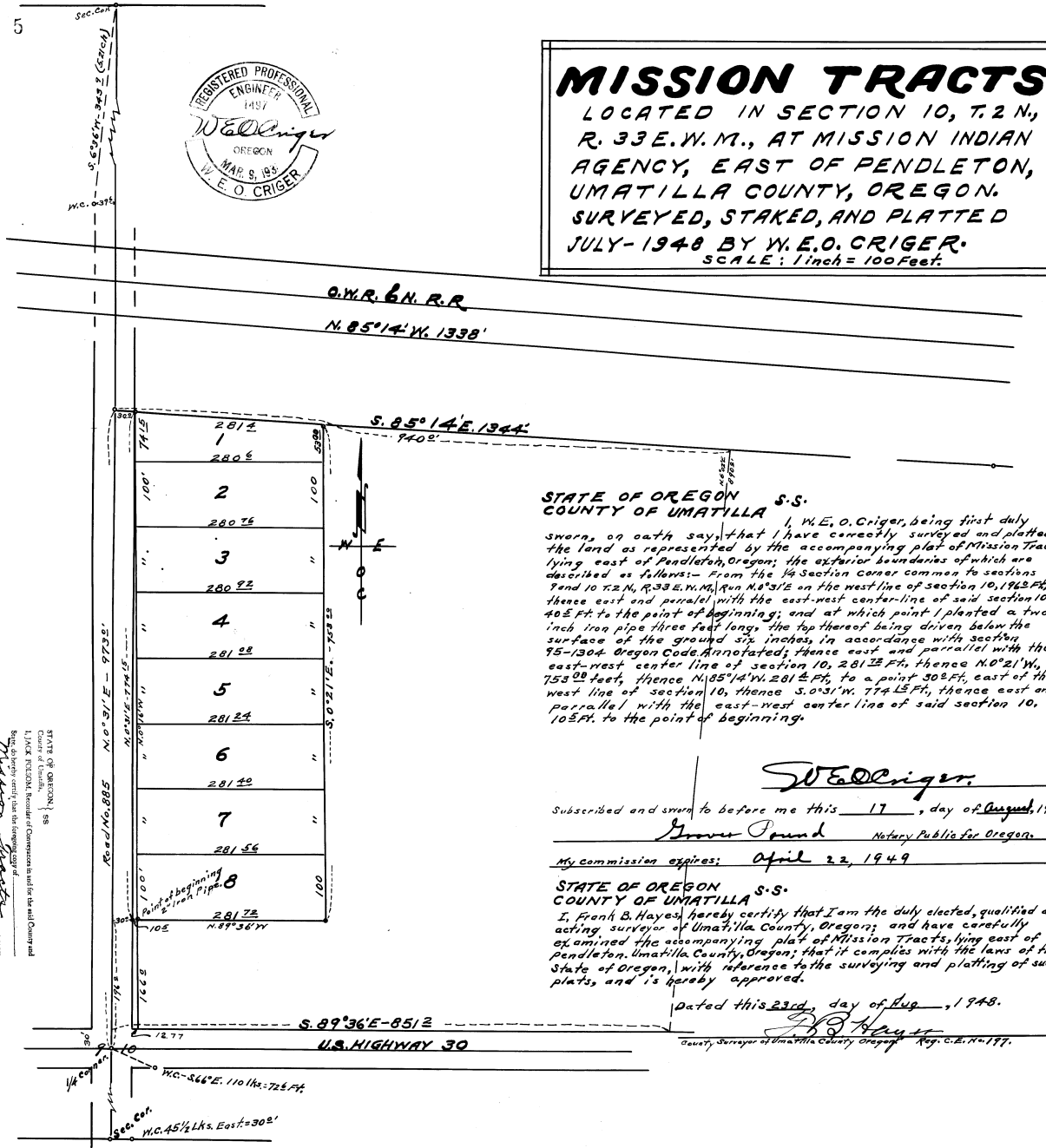

Criger, being first duly sworn, on oath say, that I have correctly surveyed and platted the land as represented by the accompanying plat of Mission Tracts lying east of Pendleton, Oregon; the exterior boundaries of which are described as follows: From the 1/4 Section corner common to sections 9 and 10 T.2 N., R. 33 E. W. M., run N. 0° 31' E. on the west line of section 10, 194.25 Ft., thence east and parallel with the east-west center-line of said section 10, 40.5 Ft. to the point of beginning; and at which point I planted a two inch iron pipe three feet long, the top thereof being driven below the surface of the ground six inches, in accordance with section 75-1304 Oregon Code Annotated; thence east and parallel with the east-west center line of section 10, 281.22 Ft., thence N. 0° 21' W., 753.98 feet, thence N. 05° 14' W., 281.22 Ft. to a point 30.2 Ft. east of the west line of section 10, thence S. 0° 31' W., 774.25 Ft., thence east and parallel with the east-west center line of said section 10, 105.25 Ft. to the point of beginning.
