



NARRATIVE:

The purpose of this survey is to stake Lot 7, Block 8 so a manufactured home can be sited with the correct setbacks.

I do not know the origin of any of the monuments found except the two, as shown, but they fit the original 1942 Criger Plat reasonably well. As I have stated in previous surveys in "OSBURN TRACT HOMESITE," Criger did not do good work and I do not think that he set iron monuments at many (if any) lot corners.
