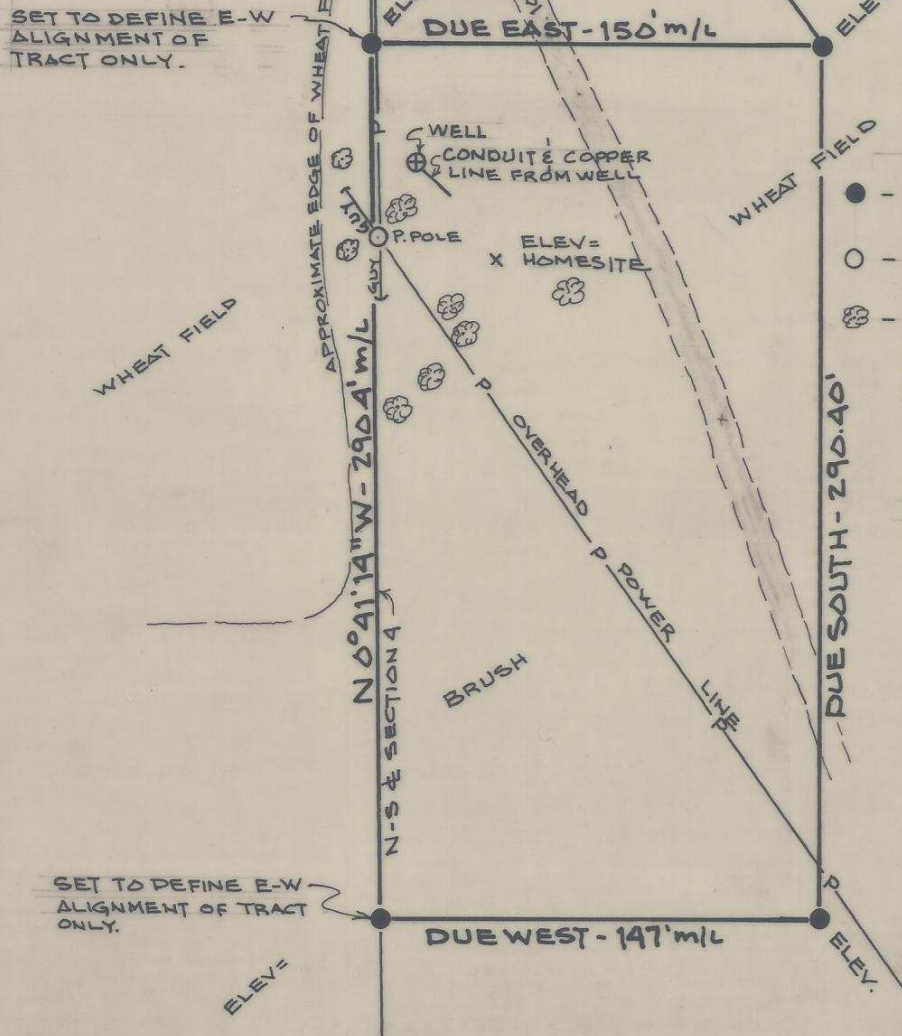

The North, South and East lines of the tract were determined as shown on the Map of Survey and are within the exterior boundaries of the original Indian Allottee George Takipse.
