

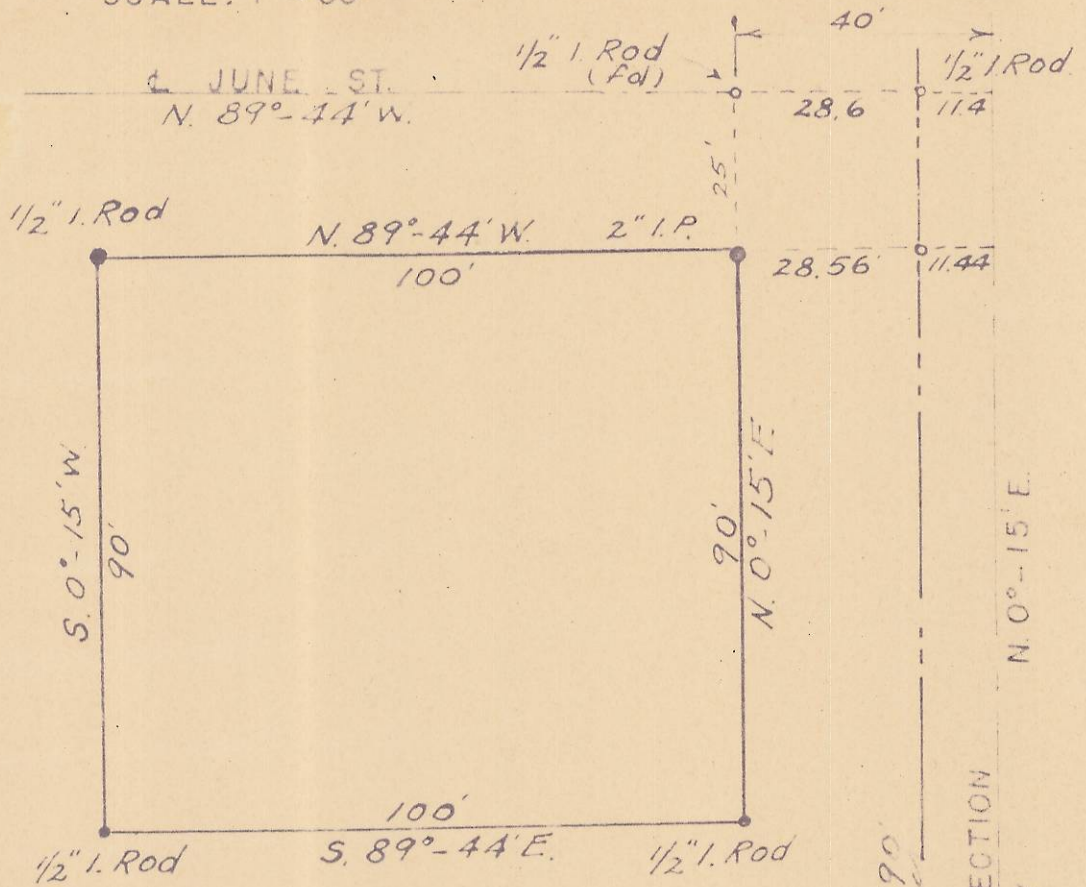
A TRACT OF LAND

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Field Notes

I began the survey at the East $\frac{1}{4}$ corner of Section 10 T. 4 N. R. 28 E. W. M., which is a Ore. Highway Dept. bronze disk set in a steel receptacle box. Established line between this point and the N. E. Corner of said Section 10, which is a $\frac{5}{8}$ iron Pin. Used Oregon Highway Dept. bearing of N. 0° -21' E. for this line.

Found some Iron pins in the Campbell- Tiller Addition from which points I established the centerline of June Street. Brought this line to an intersection with the East line of the section and checked the bearing of June Street.

From this data I layed off the area as shown on the accompanying sketch.
