

NARRATIVE


The purpose of this survey was to show the boundary line between Friesen and McAllister parcels as they are described on Roll 130 Pages 1028 and 1429 respectively, in the Southeast one-quarter of the Southeast one-quarter of Section 23, Township 6 North, Range 35 East, N.M.

The West line of the property is established as the East right-of-way line of the Walla Walla Valley Railroad. The North line of the property is the South right-of-way line of County Road No. 247, Ferdale Road. The East and South lines were established in a survey for Englehart-Anliker, Umatilla County Surveyor No. 1-14-B. Points shown as found were established in that survey.

Bearings are based upon the bearing of County Road No. 247 bearing being 689°43'39\"E as shown on Umatilla County Surveyor No. 85-41-B.
