SURVEY NARRATIVE

The monuments shown hereon were set to replace those destroyed during the construction of new streets and sidewalks along Spruce Street and Dogwood Avenue. They were reset using ties made during the initial design survey for the improvement project and are in the same positions as the original monuments. Bearings are based on the Centerline of Dogwood Avenue being $589^{\circ}33'10''$ E per CS#95-127-C.
