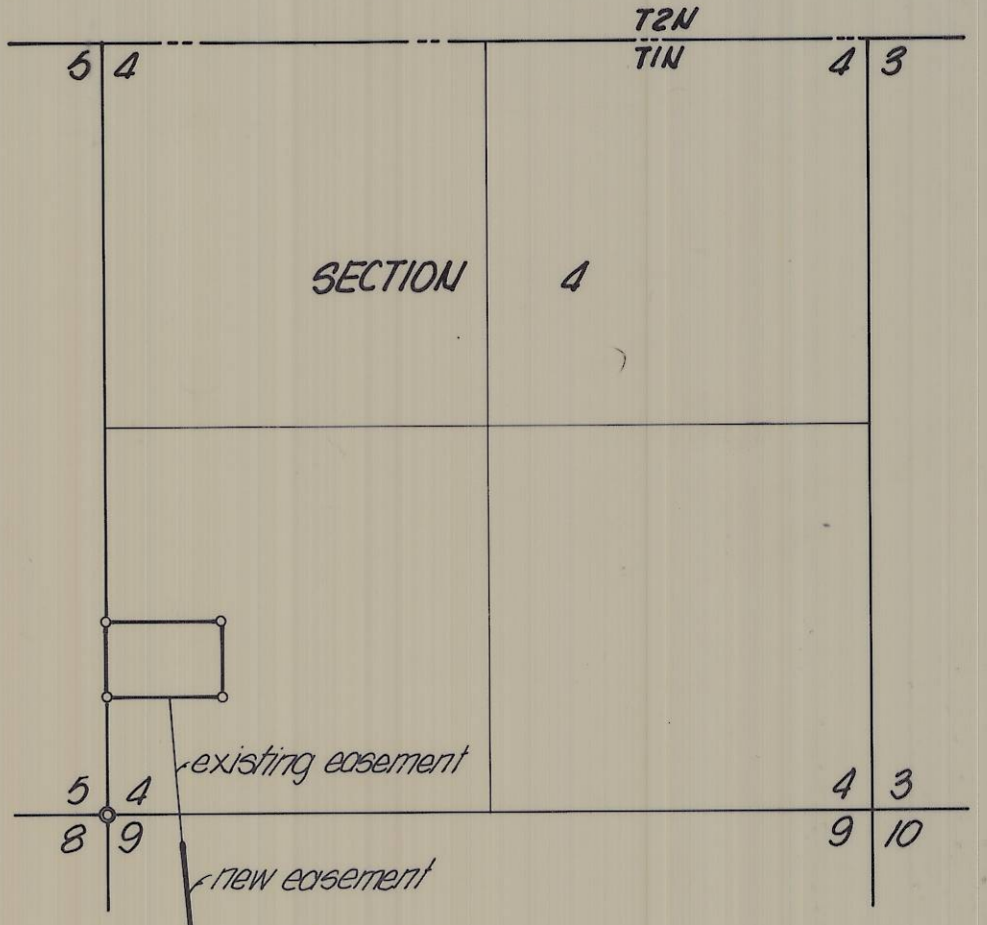


NOTE
