Report of Viewers.

To the Hon. County Court for Umatilla County, State of Oregon.

We the undersigned viewers on Road Survey No 303 for Umatilla County, Oregon, would respectfully report that we met at the time^{and} place appointed for the same, ^{and} with the County Surveyor Jno. C. Arnold, proceeded to view out^{and} survey said road as directed by law for the same. We find the road to be upon good ground ^{and} needed as an outlet to the town of Weston, in said County, via of O. R & N. Co's Depot, also we find the road to be needed in hauling to the grain platform for said Depot.

We would therefore recommend that said road, 303, be declared a public highway, ^{and} that the prayer of the petitioners for same be granted.

I met Boston Durr^{and} J. Kirkpatrick, viewers appointed on Road Survey No 303 for Umatilla Co. Or., at Weston, in said County ^{and} State, on the 15th day of Nov. A. D. 1887,

Calling upon Robt Kirk^{and} A. O. Kirk to act as chain bearers ^{and} Robt Kirk, as marker, ^{and} after qualifying, each, as required by law, I commence at center Sec. 16 T. 4 N. R 35 E, ^{and} run East on line purporting to have been E. & W. through center of said Sec 16.

(or 21° 30' E)	cas.	Set initial post in mound, about 50 links N. E. of Pt. Thence
589° 20' E.	49.66	Set angle stake 6 links N. of Pt. ^{and} turn 59° Right
530° 20' E.	58.90	" " " 20 " W " " " 6.10' Right
524° 10' E.	80.00	" 17 mile post in mound on line, ^{and} continue on last course which is parallel to ^{and} 100 feet west center of R. R. track
"	7.00	Set angle stake 10 lks. south of point ^{and} turn 37° 10' Left
561° 20' E.	9.50	Intersect O. R & N. Co's R. R. track 34 chs. south of Depot.
	11.90	Set terminal post in mound on lower side of graded road from O. R & N. Depot to town of Weston.

For about 40 rods more than the first half mile of this road, a lane is built, ^{and} the road is traveled; the whole road is located on good ground.
