

of 400 ft. then set an angle stake and ran $S 39^{\circ} 30' E$ a distance of 300 ft to the angle stake on the bank of the Creek and marked in notes as being 2900 ft from place of beginning. This makes a difference in the location of mile of 620 ft in the total distance and there is therefore that much difference in the location of mile posts and angle stakes as made by original survey and that brought about by the change in location. As there was from two to four feet of snow on the level we did not deem it advisable to attempt making these changes
