Report of Viewers, Field Notes and Plat of Survey of  
Road No 359 in Umatilla County, Oregon,

Commencing at a point in the County Road, run-  
ning from Blue Mountain Station to intersect with  
the Basket Mountain road directly opposite the residence  
of Mr. J. M. Phillips and running thence along the main  
traveled road on the north side of Dry Creek one thousand  
feet more or less to a point where the north and south  
Sections line between Sections eleven and twelve Twp.  
4 NR. 35E crosses the said County road and there terminating

To the Honorable the County Court of the State of  
Oregon, for Umatilla County,

We the undersigned, viewers beg leave to report  
that we met J. W. Fawcay, Surveyor at Weston, Monday  
June the 22<sup>d</sup> 1891, and having called to our aid R. M.  
Powers and E. S. Keeney to act as chainmen and markers  
we and each of us were duly qualified by the Surveyor  
as directed by law and proceeded forthwith to view  
survey and locate said road.

We find that a road on said location given is very  
much needed and is at the present time almost  
impassable, we recommend that the petition be  
granted and Road No 359 be declared a County Road.

We further find that said road crosses the creek four  
times, that it would require about ten thousand  
feet of lumber to cover said bridges; we further find  
that the channel of said creek could be easily changed  
with but little labor; therefore we would recommend  
that the channel of said creek be changed and that there  
be no more than no bridges built.
