Report of Viewers, Field Notes and Plat of Road
No 373 in Umatilla Co Oregon,

Commencing at the NE. Corner of Sec 25 Township
4 NR. 34 E, thence south on township line to the
brakes of the Umatilla River, thence on the most
practicable route down the hill to the center of the
Umatilla River.

Said road to be 60 feet wide.

In the matter of viewing, surveying and laying out
County Road No 373.

To the Honorable County Court, of the State of Oregon for Umatilla
County.

We, the undersigned, the viewers heretofore appointed
to view and locate Road No. 373. submit the following
report: Pursuant to an order of the Honorable
Court we met W. A. Thompson, Surveyor, at Athena,
on Aug. 10th 1891, and were by him, each duly
sworn to faithfully and impartially discharge
the duties of our appointments.

We called to our aid Henry Zahner } Chainmen

who were by the surveyor, each, duly sworn.
We viewed, surveyed and located said Road No. 373
as specified in our order.

We would recommend that the road be allowed,
as we find the same to be a practicable route,
and for most of the distance it is now open^{ed}
in reasonable good condition for travel. We
find that four small culverts will be needed on
the road. The road from beginning to the brakes
of the Umatilla River will require but little work
to make a good road, and a very good grade
down the brakes to the river can be made, up which
a ordinary span of horses can draw 1500 pound.
