In the matter of the Viewing, Surveying and Laying out of County Road No 387, described as follows, to wit:

Commencing at about the center of the North line of the South East quarter of the South West quarter of Section Twenty nine (29) and run South through the South West quarter of the South West quarter of Section Twenty nine (29) to Section line between Sections Twenty nine (29) and Thirty Two (32) thence West on Section line to North West corner of Section Thirty Two (32) thence South on or near line between Sections Thirty One (31) and Thirty two (32) one half mile $\frac{1}{2}$ mile intersecting Road to Gun Spring also to vacate that portion of County Road commencing about the center of the North line of the South East quarter of the South West quarter of Section Twenty nine (29) and running South about one half mile thence in a South Westwardly direction to South East corner of the North East quarter of Section Thirty One (31) all of above roads and lands in Township Six (6) North Range 35 East Willamette Meridian, said Road to be 40 ft wide

- Report of Viewers -

To the Hon County Court for Multnomah County Oregon

We the undersigned viewers on road survey No 387 would respectfully report that we met Jno C. Arnold Esq Surveyor at the time and place specified in our several appointments and were by him duly qualified as required by law

We called suitable Assistants to wit, Jacob Hill, J.P. Rodgers and W.M. Rodgers who were likewise qualified we view out and surveyed said road as prayed for by the Petitioners thereof and find the road located upon as good ground comparatively as the present traveled road, runs upon subdivisional Section lines instead of angling through private lands as the present traveled road and the distance no greater

We would therefore recommend that the prayer of the petitioners for said road survey No 387 be granted
