In the matter of viewing, surveying and laying out county no. 384 commencing eighty rods (807) south of the north west corner of section twenty two (22) Township Six (6) north Range thirty five (35) East of the Willamette meridian thence east about forty (407) rods to the old Railroad bed thence in a northerly direction to the section line between section fifteen (15) and twenty two (22) thence east to the north east corner of section twenty two (22) to intersect a county road leading from the state line to the City of Milton in said County.

Report of Viewers

To the Honorable County Court, of the State of Oregon for Wasatch County,

we, the undersigned, the viewers heretofore appointed to view and locate road no 384 submit the following report: Pursuant to an order of the Honorable Court we met John C. Arnold County Surveyor, at Milton on Feby. 24th A.D. 1892 and were by him, each duly sworn to faithfully and impartially discharge the duties of our appointment.

who were by the Surveyor, each, duly sworn. We viewed, surveyed and located said road no 384 as specified in our order we find the route practicable, and the ground good, The road appears to be important as a connection of outlets to settlers in its vicinity; the road will be easily opened and kept in repair; the same is somewhat traveled at this time. We would therefore recommend that said road be declared a public highway.
