Field notes of Road Survey No 398 for Umatilla Co Oregon

I met H. S. Frazier, Geo Dehann and A. M. Egan at Milton Aug 29th 1892, and duly qualify each as required by law, to act as Viewers on Road Survey No 398 for Umatilla County Oregon. H. M. Ritter and J. C. Hill called to chain and mark, each duly sworn as required by law.

I set Initial post for Road No 398, regulation size and marks, in mound of gravel stones, regulation size, 12 links N of the 14 sec. cor bet secs. 26+35. 36 N. R 35 E. against fence on E. side of lane course N. & S. and on S. side of mouth of lane course E. and, under direction of said Viewers, I run from said 14 sec cor., East, along traveled road in lane Va. N 21° E.

- 32.50 " 10 " " " North
- 39.21 Cor. to secs. 25-26-35-36
- 44.00 Irrigating ditch, from South, turns E. 20 lks. S. of line
- 61.50 Intersect middle Milton & Walla Walla Wagon road.
Set regulation terminus, in stone mound.
