

Field notes of Road Survey No 417 for Umatilla County Or.

I met H. Flickinger, Burr Johnson and Frank Conn, Viewers on road survey No 417 for Umatilla County Or at Court house on March 1st. 1893. and call Edgar Thomson to assist Dpty. H. M. Ritter in chaining and marking each of whom Qualify as required by law.

Under direction of said Viewers, I set initial post in said road survey 30 ft S. E. of Cor. to Secs 1-2-35+36 on line bet. Tps 1+2 N. R. 32 E. and from said Sec. Cor. I run E. on true Tp line.

- 300 ft. Descend gently
- 900 " Foot of hill
- 950 " Ravine Course N.
- 1000 " Ascend
- 1200 " Summit +25'
- 2625 " Stake bears N. 1/4 Sec. Cor. stone
- 3920 " Dry Tuleilla 40 wide x 10 deep. Course N. W.
- 4300 " Ascend
- 5140 " Stake N+S on W. side of road same course
- 5270 " N.E. Cor. Tp. 1 N. R 32 E.

Set terminus 42 ft. S.E. of said Cor.

All the posts are of regulation size and are marked and set in mounds as required by law.
