To the Honorable County Court of the State of Oregon, for Umatilla County,

We, the undersigned, the Viewers heretofore appointed to view and locate
Road No. 476 submit the following report. Pursuant to an order of
the Honorable Court we met John W. Kimbrell Surveyor, at the Court
House, in Pendleton Or. on the 10th day of Feb. 1896 and were by him
each duly sworn to faithfully and impartially discharge the duties
of our appointments.

We called to our aid Doro Turner, James Whorkley
Chairman, J.W. Kimbrell, marked
who were by the Surveyor, each duly sworn. We viewed, surveyed
and located said Road No. 476 as specified in our order and find the
route practicable and would most respectfully recommend the same be
established and declared a public highway

Field Notes of Road No 476

I commenced at a point S. 49° 30' E 19.18 chains distant from the N.W.
corner of the NE 1/4 Sec. 9 in Township 2 north of Range 32 East N.W.
Set post 4 x 4 inches square and 4 feet long marked R 476, dug pits East
and West and built mound of earth 4 feet wide at base and 18 inches
high around post 30 feet East of the initial point
Thence North 1.75 chains to county road on the north side of
O R & N. Pac. Rail Road set post 4 x 4 inches square and 4 feet long
30 feet West of road terminus marked R. J. No 476, dug pits and raised
mound of earth around post.
