

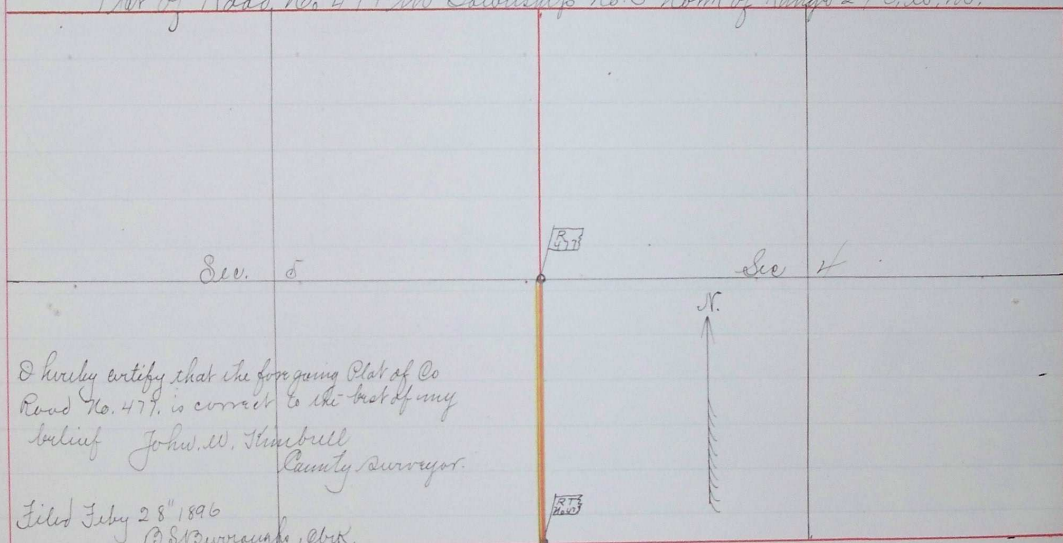

Then I ran South bet. sections 4 and 5 40° chains to the corner to Sec. 4-5-899. set post 30 feet west and 30 feet north of the terminus of road marked R. No. 477 dug pits west and north of posts and built mound 4 feet wide at base and 18 inches high around post
