We called to our assistance Gary Kimbrell and J M Ferguson, as chainmen and J N Kimbrell as marker, who were duly qualified as such.

Commencing at a point on County Road leading from Cold Spring to Pendleton, do wit- at NE corner of S.E. 1/4 Section 26, in T 3 N R 32, E 11 M, set post 4 inches square, 4' long 80' E of initial point. Marked R 509; dug pits 24x24x12, ins N + S of post and built mound of earth, 4' wide at base, 18 ins. high around post.

Thence South bet. Secs. 25 & 26, 35 & 36 T 3 N R 32 E 11 M, one mile to NE corner S.E. 1/4 Sec 25 of said Township and range. Set post 4 ins. square 4' long 30' S of corner, marked 1 m. Dug pits S.E. + West 20x20x12 ins. Made mound 4' wide 18 ins high around post. Thence west 39.65 chs. to center Sec. 25; thence South 11.45 chains; thence West 14.75 chains; thence S 50° N. 3.15 chains, 80.00; Set post 4 ins sq. 4' long, 30' to the right, marked 2 M. Dug pits 24 x 24 x 12 ins N E + S N and built mound of earth around post 4' wide at base 18 ins high.

Thence S 50° N 5.80 chains to stake marked R on road to Lee Street Bridge; Set post 4 inches square 4' long 30' right of terminus, marked P. J. N° 509. Dug pits N E + S N 24 x 24 x 12 inches and built mound of earth 4' wide at base, 18 ins high around post
