In the Matter of Viewing, Surveying and Laying out County Road No 526.

To the Honorable County Court of the State of Oregon for Umatilla County We the undersigned the Viewers heretofore appointed to view and locate road # 526 in Submit the following report. Pursuant to an order of the Honorable Court we met C. E. Macomber, Surveyor at J. D. Hargett, June 4, 1901, and were by him each duly sworn to faithfully and impartially discharge the duties of our appointments.

We called to our aid, A. Nichol & M. L. Morrison, Chaimen J. D. Hargett Marker who were by the Surveyor each duly sworn. We viewed Surveyed and Located said Road No 526 as specified in our Order, and find that said road will be comparatively easy to construct, and that it will make a very direct means from the locality tributary to its initial point to Canon Station, and we respectfully recommend that said road be established.

Field Notes Road # 526.

June 3 and 4th 1901.

In accordance with instructions issued by the County Court of Umatilla County, at their May Term I met W. H. Bond, W. M. Scott and G. W. Knight appointed as Viewers of road 526, at the residence of J. D. Hargett, and after qualifying them by administering the oath we called to our aid, A. Nichol and M. L. Morrison as Chaimen and J. D. Hargett Marker, and proceeded to locate and survey road # 526, beginning at the NE corner, between sections 3 and 4, T. 5 N. R. 32 E. N. 7 W. from which, 20 ft East I set stake marked 526, raised mound and dug pits as per instructions.

Thence north along the line between sections 3 and 4 across hill Va. 22° 20' E
