In the matter of viewing, surveying and laying out County Road No. 549. To the Honorable County Court of the State of Oregon for Umatilla County. We the undersigned, the viewers heretofore appointed to view and locate Road No 549, submit the following report:

Pursuant to an Order of the Honorable Court we met Mr G Kimbrell Surveyor, at the House of Alex Hudson, on June 9 th. 1903, and were by him each duly sworn, to faithfully and impartially discharge the duties of our appointments

We called to our aid Jerry Barnhart, Schamman
Marker

Who were by the Surveyor each duly sworn. We viewed, surveyed, and located said road No 549, as specified in our order. This road as petitioned for can be opened, with reasonable expense, and be made a good road. With one exception, viz: the hill facing Birch creek, going west, is very steep and can only be reduced, to about 12% grade by making one or two rather sharp angles, reasonably, but as this will be the only outlet through that section of Country between Lee's Crossing and Pilot Rock, and although there are other routes through that section that would, in our judgment, be better than this one, still this having been petitioned for in due form and no due exceptions taken we therefore report favorable
