Field Notes of Road No 554.

Commencing at Sec. cor. for secs 28-29, 32 & 33 Township 3 N. Range 30 E.W.M. Set post 4 ins sq 4 ft. long, 20 ft West of initial point Marked R. No 554. dug pits north and south and built mound of earth 18 ins and 4 ft. wide at base. Thence south 57.75 chains along sec. line between Secs 32 and 33. in said Township and range set post 4 in sq 4 ft long, 20 ft West of terminus of Road. Marked R.T. No 554 dug pits North and South and raised mound of earth 18 in high and four feet wide at base.
