In the Matter of viewing, surveying and laying out County road No. 558. To the Honorable County Court, of the State of Oregon, for Umatilla County:

We, the undersigned, the viewers heretofore appointed to view and locate road No. 558 submit the following report: Pursuant to an order of the Honorable Court we met John W Kimbrell surveyor at Commencing of said road on 28th day of March, 1904, and were by him, each, duly sworn to faithfully and impartially discharge the duties of our appointments.

We called to our aid J A Martin and F Hagist, chainmen and J W Young marker, who were by the Surveyor each, duly sworn. We viewed, surveyed and located said Road No 558 as specified in our order and find the Rout practicable the expense of grading, bridges, culverts, and making said road in good condition for travel would be about \$300.00. The road is very much needed as all parties and public is compelled to open gates and travel through fields, to the detriment of all land owner along the line of said road and the public generally. The lands would not be damaged through which the road runs in any amount, but benefited, thereby we would most respectfully recommend the same be established and declared a public highway of Umatilla County, Oregon.
