 Set post 4 ins. Sq, 4 ft long, N. W. 42 feet dist marked R. 598 dug pits and
 raised mound of earth around post; thence west bet Secs. 14 and 23 to S. W. Cor of
 Sec 14, -8000 1 mile set post 42 feet N. E. marked 1.M. dug pits and raised mound
 of earth around post; thence North bet Sec. 14 and 15.
 5260 Irrigation ditch 16 ft wide course East
 6600 O. R. & N. Cos. Railroad course N. E. and S. W.
 8000 2 mile to corner to sec. 10-11-14 and 15 set post 4 ins Sq.
 4 ft long marked 2. M. dug pits and raised mound of earth around post; thence North
 bet Sec. 10 & 11.
 2330 O. R. & N. Cos. Rail Road course N. W. & S. E.
 8000 3 mile to corner to sec. 2-3-10 & 11 set post 4 ins. Sq. 30' to left marked

That we, Edwin H. Caton and Kate Caton, husband and wife, of Athena, Umatilla
 County, State of Oregon, in consideration of One Dollar, to us paid by the County
 of Umatilla, State of Oregon, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have
 bargained and sold, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell, convey and fore-
 ver dedicate to the use of the public, the following bounded and described strip
 of land to be used as a public road, situated in the County of Umatilla, State of
 Oregon, to-wit:

Beginning at a point Fourteen (14) rods North of the South-west Corner of
 the North-west quarter of Section Twenty-nine (29) Township Four (4) North, of
 Range Thirty-five (35) East of Willamette Meridian, running East Three-hundred
 seventy five and one-half (375 1/2) feet more or less, to the center of Wild
 Horse Creek, thence North along the center of Wild Horse Creek, Forty (40) feet;
 thence West three hundred seventy five and one-half (375 1/2) feet more or less,
 to the Section line between said Section Twenty-nine (29) and Section Thirty
 (30), and thence South along said Section line Forty (40) feet to the place of
 beginning.

The above description is meant and intended to describe that certain strip
 of land now used as a public highway.

Together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurten-
 ances thereunto belonging or in anywise appertaining, and also all our estate,
 title and interest in and to the same, including dower and claim of dower.

To Have and to Hold the above described and granted premises unto the said
 County of Umatilla, State of Oregon, forever., And We, Edwin H. Caton and Kate
 Caton, the grantors above named do covenant to and with Umatilla County, State
 of Oregon, the above named grantee, that the above granted premises are free
 from all incumbrances, and that we will, and our heirs, executors and administrators
 shall warrant and forever defend the above granted premises, and every part and
