REPORT OF BOARD OF COUNTY ROAD VIEWERS:

In the Matter of viewing, surveying and laying out county road No. 674.

To the Honorable county court of the State of Oregon for Umatilla county.

We the undersigned, board of county road viewers, heretofore instructed to view, survey, and locate Road No. 674, submit the following report:

Pursuant to an order of the Honorable county court we met at commencement point of said road on the 18 day of September, 1909, We called to our aid J E Bennet chairman; Dave Lavender, chainman, J W Kimbrell marker, who were by the surveyor each duly sworn. We viewed, surved and located said road No 674 as specified in our order. We find said route parcticable and would most respectfully recommend the same be established and declared a public highway of Umatilla county Oregon, the cost of construction will be about \$425.00 the lands through which the road is located by reason of the establishment of said road will be rendered less valuable in the sum of nothing.
