Report of Board of County Road Viewers. In the matter of viewing, surveying and laying out road No 693

To the Honorable County Court of the State of Oregon for Umatilla county.

We, the undersigned Board of County Road viewers, heretofore instructed to view survey, and locate road No. 693, submit the following report:

Pursuant to an order of the Honorable County Court, we met at Commencing of said road on the 13 day of July, 1910. We called to our aid,

who were by the Surveyor each duly sworn, we viewed, surveyed and located said Road No. 693 as specified in our order. We find that said route practicable and would most respectfully recommend the same to be declared a public highway of Umatilla County, Oregon

The cost of construction will be about \$80.00 consisting of corrugated iron pipes at crossing of ditches the labor of placing said pipes to be performed by the petitioners. The damage to be sustained by the property owners by reason of the establishment of said road will be nothing.
