APPEAL from the Award of Damages allowed by the Board of County Road Viewers, Road 744

Comes now J. A. Guderain by and through his attorney Geo W. Coutts and appeals to the County Court from the award of damages made by said Board of County Road viewers in the above road matter the 8 day of May 1913 in the sum of \$94.80 and for the purposes of this appeal the said J.A. Guderain alleges, that he is a resident of Road District 744 and the owner of the East half of Section 16 in Township One North, Range 32 E.W.M. in Umatilla County, State of Oregon and over which said lands said proposed road 744 is sought to be located and established as per the petition, survey, field notes, and report of said County Road viewers filed in said road matter in said County Court on the 3 day of May 1913, and to all of which reference is hereby made. That said sum of \$94.80 is wholly inadequate and insufficient to equip, build and construct 640 rods of lawful or sufficient fencing which will be made necessary should said proposed road be established over the said lands of this claimant. That the reasonable and necessary cost of fencing will be the sum of \$260. That no award or allowance whatever has been made by said Board of viewers for 5 acres of plaintiff's said lands that said proposed road will use and occupy should said proposed road be located and opened up to public travel. That the reasonable value of said 5 acres of ground will be the sum of \$125. That no award or allowance has been made by said viewers for necessary bridges or culverts which must be constructed over creeks or streams on said line of road over claimant's said lands should said road be located

That no award or allowance was made by said viewers to the said J.A. Guderain for the many inconveniences which he will suffer and sustain should said proposed road be located over his land lands.

Wherefore the said J.A. Guderain presents his claim for damages in the sum of \$500 and hereby appeals from said award of \$94.80 and decision of said County Road viewers made herein.
