

FIELD NOTES OF ROAD NO. 757

Commencing at the N.E. Corner of Section 17, T. 3 N.R. 30 E.W.M. set a post 4 ins. square $3\frac{1}{2}$ feet long 30 feet North of the initial point 18 ins. in the ground marked P. No 757 dug pits 18 ins. square 12 ins. deep, E & W of post 5 feet distant, and raised mound of earth 4 feet base, 18 ins. high around post, thence I run South 27,83 ravine N.E. 80,00 1, M. Set post 4 ins. square $3\frac{1}{2}$ feet long 20 feet to the left marked 1, M. dug pits 18 ins. square 12 ins. deep N & S. 5 feet distant, and raised mound of earth 4 feet base 18 ins. high around post.
Thence South 80,00 2 M. set post 4 ins. square $3\frac{1}{2}$ feet long 20 feet to the left marked 2, M. dug pits 18 ins. square 12 ins. deep N, & S, 5 feet distant, and raised mound of earth 4 feet base 18 ins. high around post, Thence south 80,00 R.T. to the N.E. Corner of Section 32 T. 3 N.R. 30 E.W.M. Set post 4 ins. square $3\frac{1}{2}$ feet long 30 feet S, W, of terminus, marked R, T, No. 757 dug pits 18 ins. square 12 ins. deep W & S 5 feet, distant and raised mound 4 feet base 18 ins. high around post,

The lands of J. G. Coppinger to, wit: the W/2 of section 21, T. 3 N.R. 30 E.W.M. will be rendered less valuable by reason of said road in the sum of nothing, The lands of Louis Schmuck to wit: The N $\frac{1}{2}$ of Sec. 17, the W $\frac{1}{2}$ of Sec. 16 and the E $\frac{1}{2}$ of Sec. 29 all in T, 3 N R $\frac{1}{2}$ 30 E.W.M. will be rendered less valuable by reason of the location of said road in the sum of nothing.
