To the Honorable County Court of the State of Oregon, for Umatilla County.

We, the undersigned Board of County Road Viewers, heretofore instructed to view, survey, vacate part of Road No. 653, submit the following report:

Pursuant to an order of the Honorable County Court, we met at the County Court House and proceeded to place of survey, on the 13th day of October, 1915. We called to our aid

We find that the opening of Road No. 775 will take the place of this piece of road. We recommend that this piece of road be vacated, as it will eliminate a dangerous grade crossing over the newly constructed Coyote Cutoff. Road No. 775 gives an undergrade crossing. We therefore recommend that this piece of road be vacated.
