

FIELD NOTES OF COUNTY ROAD NO. 701.

I commence at the S. W. corner of the N. W. $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 31 T. 6 N., R. 36 E., W. M. At a point 20 ft. N. and 20 ft. W. of said corner I set a post, 4 ft. long, 4 ins. square, marked R. 701; dug pits, 18 X 18 X 12 ins., N. and W. of post, and raised mound of earth, 18 ins. high, 4 ft. base, around post.

Thence following the section line, I run north 16.50 Chs. to slough 2 ft. wide, course east.

28.33 Chs. to irrigation tail ditch 2 ft. wide, course E.


36.00 Chs. to slough 3 ft. wide, course east.

40.33 Chs. to Sec. corner.

60.03 Chs. to a point 20 ft. S. of the N. W. corner of the S. W. $\frac{1}{4}$ of the S. W. $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 30 in said township and range. Thence following parallel to the subdivisional section line, 6.00 Chs. to slough 4 ft. wide, course north.

21.00 Chs. to a point 20 ft. S. of the N. E. corner of the S. W. $\frac{1}{4}$ of the S. W. $\frac{1}{4}$ of said Sec. 30, a point in present County road. At a point 20 ft. S. and 20 ft. W. of said point I set a post, 4 ft. long, 4 ins. square, marked R. T. 701; dug pits W. and S. of post, and raised a mound of earth, 18 ins. high, 4 ft. base, around post.

I hereby certify that the foregoing field notes of County road No. 701 are correct as surveyed by me on the 25th day of Apr. 1911.
