sworn on oath say that the following
description of a proposed road which
County Court for Unmatilla County
in the State of Oregon has been petitioned
to open:

Commencing at Section corner 28, 29,
32nd & 33 in Township 6 North of Range
35 E. N. M. running thence East
on section line 3/4 miles more or
less to intersect the county road known
as the Middle Milton road leading from
Milton Oregon to Walla Walla Wash-
ington; thence in a northerly direction
along said road one mile more or less
to the 1/4 section post on section line
between sections 24th & 25 in Township
6 North of Range 35 E. N. M.; thence East
on said section line 90 rods more or
less to the East bank of the Junaluska
river; thence in a southerly direction
along the East bank of said river to
a point 30 rods South of section line
between sections 24th & 25 aforesaid; thence
East 140 rods more or less to intersect
the county road known as the Upper
Milton road leading from Milton
Oregon to Walla Walla Washington;
thence North along said road 3/4 miles

to Section line between Sections 19, & 30
in Township 6 North of Range 36 E. W. M. ^{11/4}
thence East on said section line one ^{11/4}
miles more or less to intersect the
county road leading to Spofford Station
on the O. R. & N. R. R. all in Wasatch
County, in the State of Oregon, was
written plainly in the notices which were
posted for said road in by perwriting;
that they ^{saw} said notices after they were
posted & that said notices were not erased,
blurred nor blotted, but could be read by
