Order allowing road.

Now on this day this matter coming on regular to be heard upon the report of the Board of County Road Viewers, hertofore instructed to view and report upon said proposed road, the same having been continued from the August term of this court until the present time; said road being petitioned for as commencing at the Southeast corner of NE $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 35 Tp 6 N.R. 35 E.W.M, and run thence West one-fourth mile to the Southwest corner of said NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of NE $\frac{1}{4}$  said Section 36 and to be thirty feet wide as a county road, for final hearing, the same having been publicly read the first time on June 2nd 1920 and publicly read the second time on June 3rd 1920, and the said Board of County Road Viewers having reported favorably, and recommended that said road be established and declared a public road of Umatilla County, and there being no objections on file against said report of petition, it is hereby ordered that said report be approved and the said road be granted and declared a public road, and that the same be recorded in the record of plats and field notes of Umatilla County, and that the said road be opened for public use, provided however, that the petitioners pay all costs and damages accruing by reason of the opening of said road.
