ROAD NOTICE

TO ALL PERSONS WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:

Notice is hereby given that a petition will be presented to the County Court of the State of Oregon, for Umatilla County, by the Undersigned, who are freeholders of said County and State, and reside in the road district or districts of the hereinafter described route for a County road, at the ~~month~~ *April* term, 1920, of said County Court, to-wit: On the ~~1st~~ *7th* day of *April* 1920 praying said Court to lay out, locate and establish a County road in said County and State, commencing, running and terminating as follows, to-wit:

Commencing at the Southeast corner of the Northeast quarter of the Northeast quarter of section 36 in Township 6 North, of Range 35 E.W.M., Running thence West one-fourth mile to the Southwest corner of the said Northeast quarter of the Northeast quarter of section 36, Township 6 North, of Range 35 E.W.M. and connecting with the County road at each terminal.

That said road is of Public Necessity in that the Rural mail is carried over it and that patrons of school District #108 are obliged to travel an extra three-fourths mile on account of this not being open and in condition to travel.

Said road to be thirty feet wide
