

Wike County Court July term 1883  
7<sup>th</sup> Judicial day Tuesday July 10

In the matter of a change in County Road known as the Linkton Road, Commencing at a point in the aforesaid road where it crosses the N. line of Sec 27, T. 5, N. R. 36 E, thence running along the N. line of Sec 27 in an Easterly direction 200.25 rods thence in a South Easterly direction, running near to and 18 or 20 rods East of A Hopsons barn, thence Easterly 6 rods, thence South Easterly direction to S. E. cor of A Hopsons Orchard thence in a South Easterly direction and terminating where said Linkton road crosses the East line of said Sec 27, about 4 rods north of S. E. corner of said Section,

Now on this day comes the report of W. Gared and F. Y. Barber the viewers heretofore appointed at the April term 1883, of this Court to view out and report upon the location of the above mentioned change in said Linkton Road for final hearing, the same having been read on a previous day of this term, to wit: July term, 1883, and the said viewers having reported favorably and recommending the establishing of said above mentioned change as a County Road and the field notes and plat of survey being duly on file and certified to by the surveyor appointed to survey the same and there being no remonstrance on file against said roads,

It is therefore ordered by the Court that the report of said viewers be accepted, and that said change in said Linkton Road be established as a County Road in accordance with the report of said viewers, and that the report of said viewers field notes and plat of survey thereof be recorded as by law required, and that the road supervisor through whom district said change runs be directed to open the same for public use as a County Road,
