ORDER

WHEREAS the Umatilla County Board of Commissioners received a petition from Harris Pine Mills to relocate a portion of County Road #389, and

WHEREAS the portion to be relocated is described as follows:

Beginning at a point which is 362.8 feet North and 43.8 feet West of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ corner of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 34, Township 4 North, Range 37 East, W.M.; thence N 44° 33' W 462.5 feet plus or minus to the southerly right-of-way of Oregon State Highway #204, and

WHEREAS the relocated centerline is described as follows:

Beginning at a point 362.8 feet North and 43.8 feet West of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ corner of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 34, Township 4 North, Range 37 East, W.M.; thence N 26° 21' E. 150.0 feet plus or minus to the southerly right-of-way of Oregon State Highway #204.

WHEREAS the Umatilla County Roadmaster testified the relocation as petitioned would be in the best interest of Umatilla County, and

WHEREAS a Public Hearing was held on December 3, 1975, and

WHEREAS no remonstrances against the relocation were heard, now

THEREFORE the Umatilla County Board of Commissioners, finding it in the best interest of the citizens of Umatilla County, ORDER that portion of County Road #389 as petitioned to be relocated be allowed as requested.
