

IN THE COUNTY COURT OF THE STATE OF OREGON FOR UMATILLA COUNTY

In the matter of Locating, Establishing, Altering, Widening, Straightening and Changing a County Road from a point in the Southwest quarter of Section 35, T. 4 N.R. 37 E.W.M., near McDougall Camp, running Easterly on Weston Mountain to a point in the Southeast quarter of Section 32, T. 4 N.R. 38 E.W.M. near Lake Langdon. Said road being a section of the Weston-Elgin Highway. COUNTY ROAD No. 877

Now on this day this matter coming on to be heard upon the report of the Board of County Road Viewers, heretofore instructed to view and report upon said proposed road. and said report having been publicly read on two different days of the same term of Court, to-wit: having been publicly read the first time on October 3rd, 1928, and publicly read the second time on October 4th, 1928, and is now up for final hearing, and the Court finds that no objection or exceptions are on file against said road or report, and said Board of viewers, finds that said road as laid out would be a practicable and necessary one and a benefit to the general public, and recommends that said road be opened and established as a county road of Umatilla County, Oregon.

Said Board further finds that the lands through which the proposed road is laid out will not be made less valuable by reason of its establishment.

IT IS THEREFORE HEREBY ORDERED that said report of the Board of County Road Viewers, be approved, that said road be established and declared a public highway of Umatilla County, Oregon, and that the width of said roadway or right of way be a strip of land eighty feet wide, being forty feet wide on each side of its centerline.

It is further ordered that the Clerk of this Court be instructed to draw warrants to pay the necessary expenses of viewing said road and to draw warrant to pay such damages as are herewith awarded by the Board of viewers.
