

IN THE COUNTY COURT OF THE STATE OF OREGON FOR UMATILLA COUNTY

In the Matter of Locating, Establishing, Altering, Widening, Straightening and Changing a County Road.....

From a point in the Southwest Quarter of Section 35, T. 4 N. R. 37 E. W.M., near McDougall Camp, running Easterly on Weston Mountain to a point in the Southeast Quarter of Section 32, T. 4 N. R. 38 E. W.M. near Lake Langdon. Said road being a section of the Weston-Elgin Highway.

RESOLUTION

County Road No. 877

TO ALL PERSONS WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:

WHEREAS, it is deemed advisable that a County Road or Highway be located, established, altered, widened, straightened and changed in the territory known as Weston Mountain running from McDougall Camp to Lake Langdon being a section of the Weston-Elgin Highway.....

and that said Road or Highway be located, established, altered, widened, straightened and changed by resolution of the County Court of Umatilla County, State of Oregon.

AND WHEREAS, this being a regular term of the Umatilla County Court and the said Court being now in regular session, sitting for the transaction of County Business with all members of said Court present.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Court of Umatilla County, State of Oregon, sitting at the regular monthly term for the month of July 19 28, in the County Court Room of the Court House, in Pendleton, Umatilla County, State of Oregon, for the transaction of County business, that it is and is hereby declared to be the intention of the said County Court to locate, establish, alter, widen, straighten and change a road or highway on and over a route as follows:

BE IT RESOLVED that the proposed Section of the Weston-Elgin Highway shall commence, run and terminate as follows, to-wit:

Beginning at a point in the Southwest Quarter of Section 35, Township 4 North, Range 37 East, W.M. known and designated as Station 0 / 00, said point being 1568.7 feet North and 1710.0 feet West of the Quarter Section Corner on the South side of the above mentioned Section, thence running Easterly, following the survey made by the United States Bureau of Public Roads, to a point in the Southeast Quarter of Section 32, Township 4 North, Range 38 East, W.M., known and designated as Station 294 / 50 which point is on the shore of Lake Langdon and 466 feet South and 570 feet West of the Quarter Section Corner common to Sections 32 and 33, Township 4 North, Range 38 East, W.M.

The right of way or roadway to be a strip of land Eighty feet wide, being Forty feet wide on each side of the center line of the above described line.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a public necessity for the said road or highway is hereby declared to exist for the following reasons, to-wit: It is a link of the Weston-Elgin Highway connecting Umatilla and Union Counties and will provide an outlet for the timber and other products of Weston Mountain.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the above entitled matter be heard at the regular August term for the year 1928, of said County Court at the County Court House at Pendleton, in the County of Umatilla, State of Oregon.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that true copies of this Resolution, properly certified to as such by the County Clerk be posted by the County Roadmaster as follows, to-wit: That a copy be posted upon the bulletin board in the west corridor of the County Court House in Pendleton, Oregon, said Court House being the place where the County Court is held; That three copies be posted in three public places in the vicinity of the said proposed road; And that this Resolution be duly entered in the Commissioners Journal.
