between sections 24 and 25 in Tp. 4 North of Range 35 E.W.M. thence along the present travelled county road South 81° 35' East 10.67 chains; thence North 83° 30' East 14.74 chains; thence North 70° 08' East 3.96 chains; thence South 71° 00' East 2.84 chains; thence South 53° 34' East 4.55 chains; thence South 11° 56' East 5.28 chains; thence South 61° 36' East 1.75 chains; thence North 85° 28' East 2.23 chains; thence South 44° 26' East 2.69 chains; thence South 83° 21' East 3.99 chains; thence South 48° 32' East 4.20 chains; thence South 41° 30' East 7.17 chains; thence South 39° 59' East 3.70 chains; thence South 15° 00' East 4.27 chains; thence South 10° 47' East 2.87 chains; thence South 59° 00' East 4.80 chains, to intersect with the present travelled road;
