the following described premises, ~~to-wit~~: situated in Umatilla County and State of Oregon to-wit:- Commencing at the North east corner of Section four (4) in Township five (5) North, of Range thirty-five (35) E. W. M. Running thence North along the line between Sections 33 and 34 in Township 6 North, of Range 35 E. W. M. One hundred thirty two and $\frac{32}{100}$ ($132\frac{32}{100}$) rods; thence Northwesterly towards a point on the line running East and West through the center of said Section 33, $47\frac{16}{100}$ rods West of the N.E. corner of the S. E. $\frac{1}{4}$ of said Section, to a point one rod west of the East line of said Section 33. ; thence South parallel with and one rod from said East line of Section 33, One hundred thirty two and $\frac{1}{2}$ ($132\frac{1}{2}$) rods more or less to the South line of said Section 33: thence West twenty three and $\frac{1}{2}$ ($23\frac{1}{2}$) feet: thence South twenty (20) feet: thence East forty (40) feet: thence North twenty (20) feet to the place of beginning
