Road No. 734

Now on this day this matter coming on regularly to be heard upon the report of the Board of County Road-viewers heretofore, instructed at the January 1912 term of this Court, to view, survey, stake, layout and report upon said proposed road No. 734 petitioned for as follows: Commencing at a point N. 66°40' West, 21.72 chains distant from the center of Sec. 2, Tp 5 N. R. 35, E W M., thence North 66° 40' West parallel with and 70 ft. from the center line of the O-W R & N Co's railroad to a point 230 ft. South of the Northwest corner of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. 3, Tp 5 N. R. 35 E W M., thence North 12.65 chains, thence North 59° West; to a point 6.60 chains South of the Northwest corner, SW $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. 34, Tp 6 N. R. 35, E W M., and to be 40 feet wide as a County road for Final hearing, the same having been publicly read on two different days of the same term of court, to-wit: having been publicly read the first time on February 8th, 1912, and publicly read the second time on February 9th, 1912, and the said Board of County Road-viewers having reported favorably and recommended that said road be established as a County road and the plat and field notes being on file and certified to by the surveyor appointed to survey the same, and the court being satisfied that said road would be of sufficient public utility and there being no remonstrance or objections on file against said report

It is hereby ORDERED that said report of the Board of County Road-viewers be approved and that the plat and field notes be recorded in the record of plat and field notes of Umatilla County and that the road Supervisor through whose district said road runs, be and is hereby ordered and instructed to open said road for public use.
