TO ALL WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:—

Notice is hereby given that the undersigned, who are residents and house-holders within Umatilla county, Oregon, residing within the vicinity of the proposed county road hereinafter mentioned, and particularly described, will petition the county court of Umatilla county, state of Oregon, at its next regular term, to-wit: The July term of said court, 1890, commencing Monday, July 7th, A. D. 1890, to lay out, locate, establish and open up for public travel, a county road described as follows, to-wit: Beginning at the county road now running north and south through the middle of section sixteen, (16) in township four (4) north range thirty-five, (35) E. W. M., in Umatilla county, Oregon at the south-west corner of the north-east quarter, ( $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of section sixteen (16) township four, (4) north range thirty-five, (35) E. W. M., on said county road, thence running in an easterly direction on the subdivision half section line running east and west through the center of section, fifteen (15) and sixteen (16) of said township four, (4) north range thirty-five (35) E. W. M., to a point on said sub-division half section line, one hundred (100) feet west from the center of track of the Oregon Railway & Navigation Co's "spur" which runs from the main line of said company's Spokane branch to the city of Weston, in said county of Umatilla, state of Oregon, thence running in a southerly direction, along the west side of said spur on a line parallel to said spur, and one hundred (100) feet distant from the center of said spur, to the corporate limits of said city of Weston, Umatilla county, Oregon, at a point on the boundary line of said corporate limits of said city of Weston, one hundred (100) feet in a westernly direction from the center of said spur.
