Your Petitioners the undersigned  
House holders and Free holders residing  
in the vicinity of said Road;

Do most respectfully request your  
honorable body to grant us the  
following described route forty feet  
wide for a public Highway, as follows  
to wit;

Commencing at Wild Horse Creek  
in the County of Umatilla State of  
Oregon, at the South East corner of J  
Kilsons Farm, thence North to the inters  
action of the Weston and Lindleton Road,  
thence West on said Road, one fourth ( $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of  
a mile, thence North three and one half  
( $3\frac{1}{2}$ ) miles, thence a North westerly  
direction so as to pass near the spring  
near the house of Mr. Gurs.  
thence on the nearest and best route  
to the low gap in the ridge between  
Pine and Dry Creeks near the house  
of Wisdom in said County, thence  
a North Easterly direction, so as to pass  
South East of the South East corner of  
Samuel Johnsons place, where it now  
stands on Dry creek in said County

Thence a North Eastwardly direction so as to pass west of the South East Corner of the South West quarter of Section twenty nine (29) in Township six (6) North, of Range thirty five (35) East in said County. Thence to or near the School house, near the Centre of the South East quarter of said Section twenty nine (29) Thence North on or as near the line thru the Centre of the South East and North East quarters of Sections twenty nine (29) and twenty (20) in said Township, to the intersection of the line running East and west between Sections sixteen (16) and twenty (20) in said Township, Thence East on said line to the North East Corner of the <sup>North west quarter of the</sup> North West quarter of said Section twenty one (21), Thence North on or as near the line, as the ground will admit of, thru the Centre of the South west and North west quarters of said Section sixteen (16) to the intersection of a Public Highway, on the line between the State of Oregon and Washington Territory, a leading to the City of Walla Walla in said Territory.

And your Petitioner, most respectfully request your honorable body to cause such legal proceedings to be had as to cause said route to be viewed and surveyed according to law, and to be declared a public Highway.

And your Petitioners therefore as in  
 duty bound will ever Pray &c.
