location of the above mentioned road as a County road for final hearing, the same having been read on a previous day of this term of this Court, to wit Sept Term, 1888 <sup>and</sup> it appearing from said report that said viewers duly met at the time <sup>and</sup> place appointed <sup>and</sup> were duly qualified before entering upon the discharge of their duties in this behalf, <sup>and</sup> it further appearing from said report that the said viewers have estimated <sup>and</sup> appraised the damage sustained to the land of James Meggs at the sum of One hundred (\$100<sup>00</sup>) Dollars.

And it also appearing to the Court that the viewers heretofore appointed to view out <sup>and</sup> report upon the location of the above mentioned road duly made their report at the Sept Term 1888 of this Court, <sup>and</sup> that said viewers reported favorably <sup>and</sup> recommend the location of the same as a County Road <sup>and</sup> the filed notes <sup>and</sup> plat of survey of said road being duly on file <sup>and</sup> certified to by the Surveyor appointed to survey the same.

It is therefore ordered by the Court that the report of said viewers be accepted, <sup>and</sup> that the road be established in accordance with said report, <sup>and</sup> that the report of said viewers, filed notes <sup>and</sup> plat of survey thereof be recorded as by law required upon payment by the petitioners herein to said James Meggs or his Attorney the sum of One hundred (\$100<sup>00</sup>) Dollars as awarded him as damages by the said viewers R. Price <sup>and</sup> E. D. Stillman <sup>and</sup> the satisfaction of said sum having been paid to be filed with the Clerk of this Court by the petitioners herein.

And that upon said satisfaction of the payment of said damages being filed as ordered, the Road Supervisors through whose District said road runs be directed to open the same for public use as a County road.
