

IN THE MATTER OF VIEWING, SURVEYING AND LAYING OUT COUNTY ROAD NO. 368

To the Honorable County Court, of the State of Oregon, for Umatilla County :

We, the undersigned, the Viewers heretofore appointed to view and locate Road No. 368 submit the following report: Pursuant to an order of the Honorable Court we met County Surveyor, at Pendleton on as per our appointments and were by him, each, duly sworn to faithfully and impartially discharge the duties of our appointments.

who were by the Surveyor, each, duly sworn. We viewed, surveyed and located said Road No. 368 as specified in our order

We find the old road from Pendleton to Athena plowed up and fenced in, in many places, while in most instances, provisions seem to have been made by the owners of land lying along the line of the proposed road, 368, for the location of said road, in the way of leaving lanes in their fencing, &c. The road is located upon good ground, and is identical with road 367 for 5 miles; we find a narrow lane, about 20 feet in width, leading northward from the bridge across the Umatilla River, and since both sides of the lane are built of barbed wire, dangerous accidents are liable to happen in this narrow lane. We recommend that the prayer of the said petitioners for said road 368 be granted. Witness our respective hands at Pendleton Oregon, August 30. 1891
