Now, on this day comes C. J. Barrett, David Taylor and W. H. Hoopes, representing the City of Athena and presents to the Court, properly executed deed, conveying and dedicating to the use of the public, the strip of Land described therein for a County road, and it appearing to the Court, that the said City of Athena, is the owner of said described land, and that it is a suitable location for a County road.

It is therefore ordered by the Court that said road be accepted, as a County road or a road of public Easement and the Supervisor in whose district said road is located, is hereby ordered, to place the same in proper condition for public use, and said above described road shall hereafter be known as County Road # 530.
