FINAL ORDER.

NOW ON THIS DAY this matter coming on before the County Court of Umatilla County,
Oregon, sitting for the transaction of County business, for final hearing, and it appear-
ing to the Court that a Resolution was adopted on the 12th day of March, A.D. 1931, by
this Court, declaring its intention to locate, establish, alter, widen straighten and
change a road or highway on and over the hereinafter described route, said road or high-
way to be a strip of land 40 feet wide, being twenty feet on each side of the hereinafter
described center line, the detailed map and plat of said road and highway as surveyed now
being on file in the office of the Umatilla County Roadmaster, at Pendleton, Oregon.

And it further appearing to the Court that the above entitled matter was present-
ed to the County Court at a regular term of said court for April, 1931, at the County
Court House at Pendleton, Umatilla County, Oregon, on the 15th day of April, A.D. 1931, at
the hour of 10 o'clock a.m. of said day.

And it further appearing to the Court that true copies of the said resolution
herein were certified to as such by the Clerk of this Court, and were posted by the County
Roadmaster as provided by law, and that a similar copy was served upon the owners of land
affected by the proposed action of said County Court as set out in said Resolution, thirty
days prior to the 15th day of April, A.D. 1931.

And it further appearing to the Court that no objections or remonstrances have
been presented or filed herein, and that no person or persons have appeared adversely
hereto,

And it further appearing to the Court that on the 15th day of April, 1931, by
its order duly entered of record W. E. O. Criger, County Roadmaster, E. P. Marshall,
and O. L. Babcock, were appointed as viewers of said proposed road and thereafter did
meet on the 18th day of April, 1931, at the beginning point of said road, and after be-
ing first duly sworn to faithfully and impartially discharge the duties of road viewers,
did proceed to locate said County Road upon the best and easisest grade obtainable by
the termini designated in the Resolution and did thereafter file their report in writ-
ing.

And thereafter at the next regular term of the above entitled Court following
the expiration of 10 days after the filing of said report of said Board of County Road
Viewers the same was duly and publicly read on two different dates of said Term by the
County Court of Umatilla County, Oregon.

meet on the 18th day of April, 1931, at the beginning point of said road, and after being first duly sworn to faithfully and impartially discharge the duties of road viewers, did proceed to locate said County Road upon the best and easisest grade obtainable by the termini designated in the Resolution and did thereafter file their report in writing.

And thereafter at the next regular term of the above entitled Court following the expiration of 10 days after the filing of said report of said Board of County Road Viewers the same was duly and publicly read on two different dates of said Term by the County Court of Umatilla County, Oregon.

That on the day following the second reading of said report the same was considered by the County Court and no petition for damages or remonstrances having been filed and the Court now and here being satisfied that said Road will be of Public Utility and that the amount of the damages assessed is just and equitable and the report of the viewer being fair just and favorable to the Court, the same is now hereby adopted and the Clerk of the above entitled court is hereby directed to issue warrants to the persons and in the amount designated in said report, and that the hereinafter described road, to-wit:

"Beginning at a point 481.8 feet south of the southeast corner of NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of section 4, Township 2 N, Range 33, E.W.M., thence around a 52 degree curve right for a distance of 145.9 feet; thence along a tangent with a bearing of approximately North 76 degrees East for a distance of 1195.6 feet; thence around a 8 degree curve right for a distance of 100.4 feet; thence along a tangent with a bearing of approximately S.89 degrees East for a distance of 2577 feet to an angle point with central angle of 0.15' right; thence along a tangent with a bearing of approximately S.88 degrees 45' East for a distance of 1348.8 feet to an angle point with a center angle of 0 degrees 42' right; thence along a tangent with a bearing of approximately East for a distance of 5285.7 feet to a point which is the NW corner of SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of section 1, Township 2 N, Range 33, E.W.M.

be and the same is hereby established and declared to be a public highway of Umatilla County, State of Oregon.

And it is further Ordered that said road be finally surveyed and opened and that the field notes be recorded in the records kept for that purpose in the office of the County Surveyor of Umatilla County, Oregon, and from and after the date of this Order said road shall be and the same is hereby declared to be a public Highway.
