Now on this day this matter coming on now to be heard upon the report of the Board of County Road Viewers heretofore instructed to view and report upon said proposed road and said report having been publicly read on two different days of the same term of Court to-wit: Having been publicly read the first time on August 6th, 1930 and publicly read the second time on August 7th, 1930, and is now up for final hearing and it duly appearing that no objections or exceptions are on file against said road or report and said board of viewers finds that said road as located, surveyed and laid out to be a feasible and necessary one and a benefit to the public, therefore, it respectfully recommend that it be opened and established as a County Road of Umatilla County, Oregon.

The Board also finds that the lands through which the proposed road is laid out will not be made less valuable by reason of its establishment.

The Board also finds that an agreement now exists between the County Court and A. Leisinger in which he received compensation for the right of way and, whereas fencing was furnished between Station 0-50 and State 24-00, we find that he is further damaged in the amount of nothing.

The Board finds that Otis Hampton representing the Estate of S. A. Hampton has received compensation to cover damages and fencing for crossing land of the said estate in the North East quarter of Section 27, Township 5, North Range 32, E W M, in the sum of \$250.00, and we find that
