To the Honorable County Court of Umatilla County, Oregon.

The Umatilla Wool Growers Association permanently organized in Pendleton, Oregon, September 5th 1883 unanimously adopts the following preamble and resolutions

Whereas, There appears to be no seat-commissioner in Umatilla County, as provided by law, and

Whereas, No person has been actively performing the duties of seat-commissioner, and

Whereas, There is urgent need of such an officer in this county, therefore

Resolved, That this association hereby petitions the honorable County Court to appoint a seat-commissioner for said County, and respectfully recommends J. B. Ray for such commissioner.

The Association would further represent to the Court that Mr. Henry Bowman was appointed seat-commissioner for said County on _____; that since said time he has almost entirely failed neglected and refused to perform the duties of said office as required by law, and still fails, neglects and refuses to perform said duties; that owing to the prevalence and increase of disease among sheep in said County there is immediate and urgent necessity of an officer in said County who will enforce the law relating to scab in sheep; that the above named association is a lawfully organized association, having for its object the promotion of the industry of wool growing and the enforcement of the law preventing disease among sheep; that said association is composed of a large number of the leading wool-growers of the county; that they are informed and believe that as the law providing for the appointment of a seat-commissioner provides no specified term for said officer the said office is legally vacated through lapse of time, non-user and the election of new County officers; and that there is no legal reason for not appointing a new
